CAREING FOR CHILDREN

In 2015, with the untimely passing of our former president, the OCBA board of directors voted to rename our annual golf outing the Marty Aronow Charity Golf Classic to Benefit CAREing for Children. Marty was an exemplary OCBA president (2013-2014) who helped bring to life a golf fundraiser that would support OCBA's CAREing for Children (CFC)—a 501(c)3 charity.

After a hiatus of three years due to the Covid Virus, 2023 saw the return of the Marty Aronow Charity Golf Classic. The outing raised \$20,000 which was used to buy gifts and food boxes which were donated to under privileged children and families. These gifts have been distributed by CAREing For Children to charitable organizations in Ocean County. A few examples are Providence House, Faith Community Church Food Pantry, United Methodist Church Food Pantry, Salvation Army, St. Joseph's Church Food Pantry and over a dozen more.

As we are all well aware, the last few years have been challenging from a health perspective. The onset of COVID sabotaged our efforts for the 2020 and 2021 golf outings. Caring for Children also suffered the loss of our visionary chairwoman and founder, Clare Bojus. Moreover, we had also lost our charismatic golf committee chair, Mike Reilly to COVID. These tragic losses have set back the work of CFC and diminished its impact in the communities we serve. Toward the end of 2022, CFC was able to regroup under the leadership of Barbara Farley, who had worked with Clare Bojus for several years, to maximize the impact of Caring for Children in the community. The year 2023 was a year of renewal for CFC. We look forward to many more years where we can help and serve local communities in need.

Because CFC is run strictly on volunteer power, there are no overhead costs, 100 percent of the donations go to support those in need. Likewise 100 percent of the Golf Classic's net proceeds (after golf course expenditures) are funneled directly to CFC. Over the first seven years of this event, we have raised and donated over \$136,000 worth of food and children's toys to the community. Most recently, in August of 2024, we donated 100 backpacks stuffed to the brim with school supplies to children desperately in need.

As you can see, this cause is close to our collective heart and one that, we hope you agree, is worth your time, money and effort. We are optimistic about this year's Classic so that we can help even more people.
